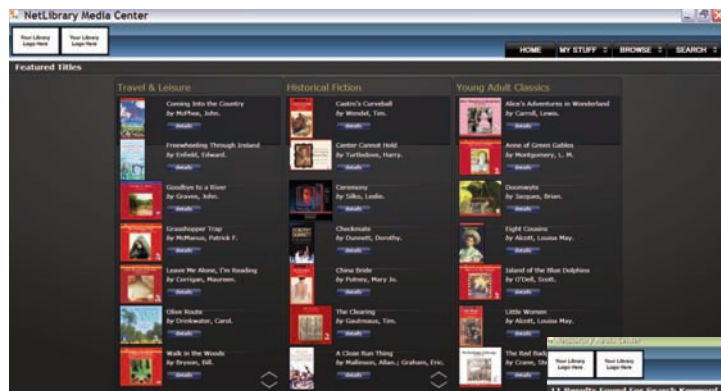

Installing Media Center

Follow the steps below to Install Media Center on your computer.

1. For first time users, patrons need to *create a user name and password*. Sign on through your library's homepage and follow the links to downloadable audio or sign on to www.netlibrary.com.
2. Look for the Media Center banner



Click on the banner to download the Media Center. The following message appears:

The Media Center installer you are about to download will perform any Microsoft updates that are necessary to get your computer up-to-date. You may want to [perform these updates manually](#) before launching the installer because the Microsoft updates can take a significant amount of time if your computer is not updated regularly. If no updates are needed, the Media Center installation takes about five minutes.

3. Click on the Install Media Center icon and follow the instructions provided.
4. The downloading of the Media Center software will only take five to seven minutes. However, depending on the age of your computer, there may be additional downloads through Microsoft. These additional downloads could take as long as thirty to forty minutes. Please be patient until all downloads are complete.



5. Close out all applications and look for the Media Center icon on your desktop. Click on the icon and the Media Center Homepage will pop up.
6. There are four categories listed on the top right of the Media Center: **Home**, **My Stuff**, **Browse**, and **Search**.
7. **My Stuff** has a *Favorites* section which you can use to go back and download one of your favorite audiobooks at a later time. The *Checked Out Items* category shows you all the audiobooks you have recently checked out and the *Help* section helps you with troubleshooting.
8. **Browse** enables you to search by a specific genre.
9. **Search** for titles using the keyword, title, author, subject and narrator. You can also search by the length of an audiobook and which format you would like to view. For example: All formats, WMA files, or MP3 (iPod®-compatible) files. Once you select the audiobook to download, the description will appear and you will also be able to tell if the book can be played on an iPod® or a standard device.
10. Clicking on *Transfer to Portable* or *Transfer to Computer* will immediately start the download process. Depending on your library's subscription model there may be some titles that will show as not currently available. If you experience this, please type your email address and you will be notified by email when the title becomes available.
11. Each track will be downloaded and updated either on your player or computer. Enjoy many hours of listening to your favorite audiobooks!
